FAQ from the community members:

Where is the voting station in Fort McKay?

The voting station is located at the Fort McKay School.



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Will there be advanced polls?

No, advance polling stations will be in the Fort McKay community.

There are however four advance voting days.

- Friday, October 9th
- Saturday, October 10th
- Sunday, October 11th
- Monday, October 12th

There are several polling stations running in Fort McMurray, including Holy Trinity High School and the Golden Years Society. Other ballot stations are running in Lac La Biche and Cold Lake. Polling stations will be open from noon to 8:00 PM.

Do I need ID (identification) to vote?

Yes, you need your driver's licence or your Status Card with your picture and address on it.



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What if I do not have any photo ID?

You do not need a photo ID to vote. However, you will be required to produce two pieces of ID.

What if my ID has no address?

Ask your membership person to write you a letter on FMFN letterhead, to state that you live or reside in the community of Fort McKay.

Or....

Take two pieces of ID and get someone that has proper ID that live in Fort McKay to Swear an Oath on your behalf at the polling station.

Please remember to bring two (2) pieces of ID that show your address.

Two pieces of ID with your name on it, such as:
