SCHOOL DETAILS

The final concept is based on the following parameters:

- Kindergarten to Grade 9 facility.
- Budget of thirty-million dollars (\$30,0 M).
- Footprint of approximately 5,000 square meters.

The Elsie Fabian School will have:

- Full-sized gymnasium.
- Career and Technology Foundations facilities.
- Classrooms that foster learning.



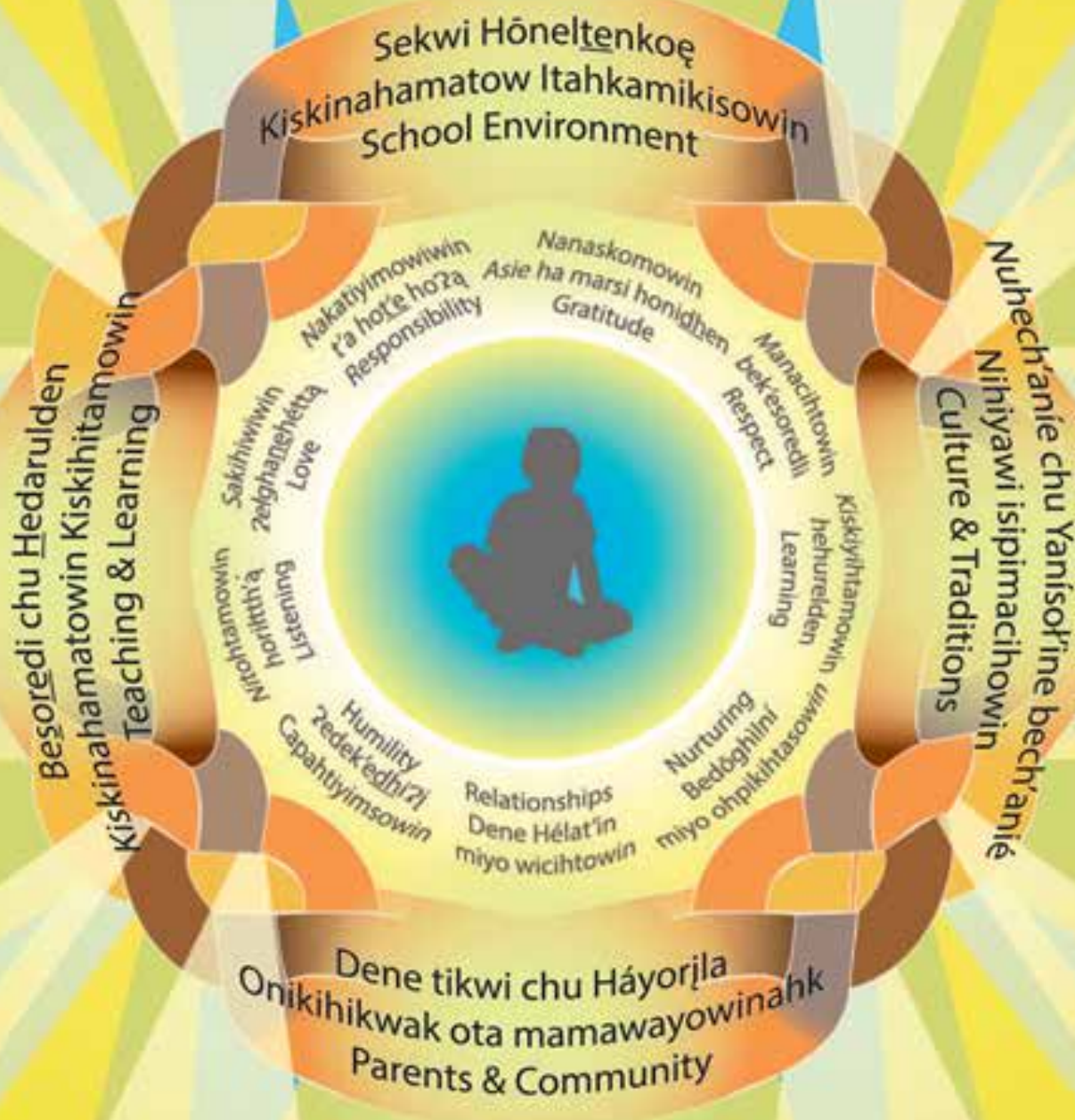
- Outdoor space for learning, sports, and activities.
