In 2021, Fort McKay First Nation worked hard to implement their new business diversification plan. The Nation invested in three new service companies in 2021, BGE Indoor Air Quality Solutions, Surepoint Group, and GlassMasters Autoglass. These investments are outside of the oil and gas industry, and outside of the Wood Buffalo Region. These new partnerships will allow us to help diversify the Nation's business portfolio and ensure its long-term financial growth and stability.

FORT MCKAY FIRST NATION

Each year, the Nation allocates capital to be deployed to expand its portfolio and acquire interests in new companies across Western Canada. As income investors, the Nation invests in companies that can produce a stable distribution to shareholders each year and limit our involvement to board oversight and governance, and business development for our growing portfolio of businesses. Fort McKay's main investment focus is in the construction, trades, industrial services and maintenance industries.
